To Operate

- To turn on the calculator, press the C/CE ke To clear an error during calculations, press the CCE key once.
 To clear the display, press the CCE key twice.

Function Keys

 - TAX+ Calculates price plus tax.
 - Calculates percentage TAX- Calculates price before tax.
- SET Calculates Multiplication. Sets tax rate.

- 4. Replace battery compartment cover and screw in place.
