





SETUP

- The ST62151 shredder will operate only when assembled correctly. Place on a flat level surface.
- 2. Place the shredder head A securely on the top of the shredder basket B.



- 3. Make sure shredder head is completely inserted onto the shredder cabinet and that it fits flush with the shredder basket **©** .
- 5. Plug the power cord into any standard 120-volt AC outlet. We recommend that you do not plug your shredder into the same outlet as other electronic devices.

DO NOT place fingers too close to feed slot as serious injury could occur.

 AVOID getting jewelry, hair or loose clothing too close to feed slot as serious injury could occur.





DO NOT use flammable synthetic oil, petroleum-based or aerosol products of any kind on shredder.



CAUTION:

- BE ADVISED this unit has moving parts which could be harmful.
- BE ADVISED this unit contains sharp objects which could be harmful.
- Never allow children to operate paper shredder, even under adult supervision. Paper shredders can pull children's fingers into the shredder mechanism.
- ALWAYS keep shredder off and unplugged when not in use.
- ALWAYS unplug shredder when moving, cleaning or emptying the waste receptacle.
- DO NOT attempt to feed more sheets of paper than specified on the feeder.
- DO NOT attempt to shred materials other than paper or credit cards in the provided feed slots.
- ALWAYS install shredder near the socketoutlet and have it easily accessible.

- ALWAYS limit continuous shredding to the specified time as suggested in the instruction manual.
- ALWAYS empty the waste receptacle prior to the receptacle becoming full.
- DO NOT attempt to operate shredder if the shredder is experiencing any kind of problem.
- ♦ DO NOT attempt to repair shredder yourself.
- DO NOT open the cover for any reason. Doing so can expose you to dangerous voltages and will void your warranty.
- DO NOT shred plastic (except credit cards), continuous forms, adhesive labels, transparencies, newsprint, or cardboard.
- This shredder is intended for indoor use only.
- Shredder should never be placed near water, over a radiator, or near a heat register.
- DO NOT use this product if it or the cord has been damaged in any way (See Power Cord Care.)
- This shredder should be used only with an operator in attendance.


POWER CORD CARE:

- Operate shredder from the power source indicated on the serial label. If you are unsure of the power source, consult your dealer or local power company.
- Since the power cord serves as the disconnect switch, make sure the shredder is plugged into an easily accessible wall outlet. The power cord cannot be replaced. If the power cord is damaged, the shredder should be discarded.
- Do not rest anything on the power cord.
- Do not place machine where persons may trip over or walk on the power cord.
- If an extension cord is used, make sure that the total ampere ratings of the products plugged into the extension cord do not exceed the extension cord ampere rating, and that the total of all products plugged into the wall outlet does not exceed 15 amp.
- Do not pick the unit up by the power cord.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

INDICATORS:

- Function Slide Switch for Reverse/Off/Auto.
- 2 Power LED Light and icon.
- 3 Switch in Reverse position and icon.
- 4 Switch in Off postion and icon.
- 5 Switch in the Auto postion and icon
- 6 Paper feed entry slot for up to 12 sheets.
- Credit card entry and icon



IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

A few pieces of shredded paper may be found inside the shredder and the wastebasket. This is normal. All Staples shredders are tested at the factory to ensure quality.

SLIDE SWITCH FUNCTIONS:

- The Rev postion is used to assist in the removal of a paper jam which reverses the shredding process prior to a completed forward cycle, thus clearing the cutters. When switching from Auto to Rev, always stop momentarily to prevent possible damage to the motor.
- The OFF postion is used to terminate the AC power to the shredder. It is recommended to turn the shredder off when the shredder is not being used for a prolonged period of time.
- When the AUTO is selected, the shredding process will start when paper is inserted into the feed opening and will continue until it has passed through the feed opening.

OPERATION:

Plug in the electrical cord. Slide the Function Switch into the Auto postion, the Power LED will light up. This means that the shredder is now ready for operation. When paper is inserted into the feed opening, the shredding process will start automatically and stop when the paper has completed its travel through the feed opening.

SHREDDING:

A maximum of 12 sheets at one pass or a single credit card recommended. Exceeding the maximum 12 sheet or multiple credit card insertions could result in unnecessary paper jams. When the paper is inserted into the feed

opening, the shredding process will start automatically and stop when the paper has completed its travel through the feed opening.

ELECTRONIC FEATURES:

- The Power LED lets you know the shredder is working and ready to shred.
- Photo sensor allows auto start, stop feature.
- Motor overload and overheat protection circuit will protect the shredder motor.

SHEET CAPACITY:

The ST62151 will shred up to twelve (12) sheets of 20-lb. bond paper and will accept paper widths up to 8 2/3 inches. When shredding small material like credit cards, envelopes, or receipts, insert them through the middle of the feed opening.

PAPER JAMS AND MOTOR OVERLOAD SITUATIONS:

The ST62151 is equipped with an automatic motor overload and an overheat protection circuit. Power will automatically terminate in case of the following abnormal situations.

- Operating the shredder at the maximum 12-sheet capacity continuously for a prolonged period of time. A running time of 7 minutes on and 30 minutes off is recommended.
- Exceeding the shredding capacity by inserting more than twelve (12) sheets of 20-lb. paper in one pass, or if the paper is not fed squarely into the feed opening.

Both abnormal operations may result in the activation of the automatic thermal motor overload protection circuit, which terminates the power to the shredder. A paper jam could

cause the thermal motor overload protection to terminate AC power to the motor. Never allow the shredder to remain in a jammed condition with the AC power turned on.

AUTO REVERSE FUNCTION:

When overload occurs, the shredder will automatically stop and reverse for 5 seconds. Wait until the shredder has finished reversing and pull the remaining sheets of paper out of the feed opening.

If jam does not clear, slide the Function Switch into the Rev postion and pull the remaining sheets of paper out of the feed opening.

IN CASE OF A MINOR PAPER JAM:

If the Auto Reverse Function does not clear the paper jam do the following:

- Slide the Function Switch into the Rev postion and pull the remaining sheets of paper out of the feed opening. Be careful not to place your fingers near the feed opening or serious harm could result.
- Make sure that all of the excess paper has been removed from the feed opening. Slide the Function Switch into the Auto postion to reset the unit.
- 3. You are now ready to resume normal shredding.

IN CASE OF A MAJOR PAPER JAM:

If the Auto Reverse Function does not clear the paper jam do the following:

- Unplug the power cord from the AC outlet and wait at least 30 minutes for the thermal overload protection to reset.
- 2. Plug in the AC power cord. If paper was left inside the feed opening prior to the overload, slide the Function Switch into the Rev postion and grasp the excess paper from the top and pull it out. Be careful not to place your fingers near the feed opening or serious harm could result.
- 3. Slide the Function Switch into the Auto postion to reset the unit.
- 4. You are now ready to resume normal shredding.
